

## Guidelines for authors

HRVATSKE VODE JOURNAL

The journal publishes scientific, conference and professional papers as well as information about all disciplines related to water.

The reviewed papers are categorised as follows:

- **Original scientific paper:** contains unpublished results of original scientific research in which research is presented in such a way that experiments can be repeated and authors' conclusions verified.
- **Preliminary report:** contains results of scientific research that need urgent publishing whereas papers don't have to contain details needed for repeating or verifying research results.
- **Review paper:** contains comprehensive overview of research based on the analysis of information that has already been published.
- **Conference paper:** contains a review of a scientific gathering that the author attended.
- **Professional paper:** contains information on the existing methods and scientific achievements that contribute to the propagation of knowledge and harmonisation of original research with practical needs.

The category of the paper is proposed by the author but the final decision is made by the Editorial Board based on the proposition of an anonymous reviewer (is not employed by the same institution as the author and having higher or equal academic level as the author). The Hrvatske vode journal also publishes papers that are not subject to review: event overviews, presentations of recent books and other publications, calendars of events, etc.

The author of the categorised paper guarantees that the accepted paper is not and will not be published elsewhere and is responsible for the data presented in the paper.

Papers and other contributions are published in Croatian. Papers may be written in English in which case the translation will be provided by the Editorial Board. All contributions are checked by the proof-reader.

Papers must be submitted in a digital format (CD-RM, DVD or e-mail) as a word document. It is recommended that the paper with all attachments should not exceed 20 pages (font size 12pt and double-spaced). In case when the length is exceeded, the author must consult the Editorial Board. A paper must contain the title, the names of the authors and their affiliations, the paper abstract and the key words.

Authors must also enclose information about themselves, i.e. name, academic title, full postal address and bank account number.

## Figures

All graphs, drawings and photographs are referred to as figures and are numbered as they appear in the text. Figures are attached in separate files and their resolution depends on the type of the figure. It is recommended to use the TIFF, BMP or JPEG while graphs should be submitted in the original format (XLS, CDR...). To avoid long captions, include legends and appropriate labelling in the figure. Exact location of each figure should be indicated in the text.




Figure 1: Average annual rainfall and runoff coefficients (measured and estimated).

The figure caption list is given in the text, after the reference list. To refer to a specific figure in the text, use the form: Fig.1.

## Tables

Tables are included at the end of the paper, after the figure caption list and are numbered as they appear in the text. The description of the symbols used in the table is given below the table.

The reference list is given in alphabetical order according to the first author's last name before the figure caption list. Indication of a reference in the text is given in brackets with the author's last name and the year of publication. In case of three authors or more, use the form Mesić et al. (2006.). All listed references must be mentioned in the text. According to the type of reference, scheme of the reference list is as follows:
